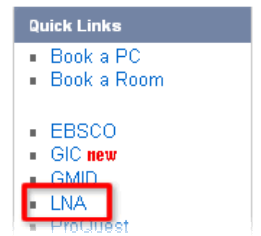
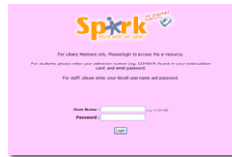


Searching LexisNexis Academic for Newspaper Articles

Go to the Temasek Polytechnic Library Portal @ <http://spark.tp.edu.sg> and select the Quick Link for **LNA**



Note: you will need to login via the pink screen



There are **TWO WAYS** to search for newspaper articles:


1.) If you want to specify a **date**, use "**Combined Search**"

- enter your keywords in the 'Search For' box, e.g. "singapore culture"
- select any date from "Today" to "All available dates"

Note: World News includes the Straits Times and the Business Times

2.) If you want to specify a **source**, use "**Search the News**"

Click on the title from the results list to read the article.
