9 Ms Tjin Lee, 34, is the managing director of Mercury Marketing And Communications, a public relations and event organising outfit. A former fashion marketing executive with Club 21, she founded Mercury in 2001.

Together with fashion choreographer Daniel Boey, she was the organiser of last year's Singapore Fashion Festival, the biggest in the event's history.

THE fashion industry in Singapore faces a setback in 2009, with the cancellation of both major annual events - Singapore Fashion Week (SFWeek) and Singapore Fashion Festival (SFF).

The cancellations will be keenly felt by the fashion industry. Already, retailers are cutting back on shows and big events this year, and the fashion industry is set to face a year of contraction and economic depression. Singapore designers will lack a credible, world-class showcase that will attract media coverage and potential buyers.
