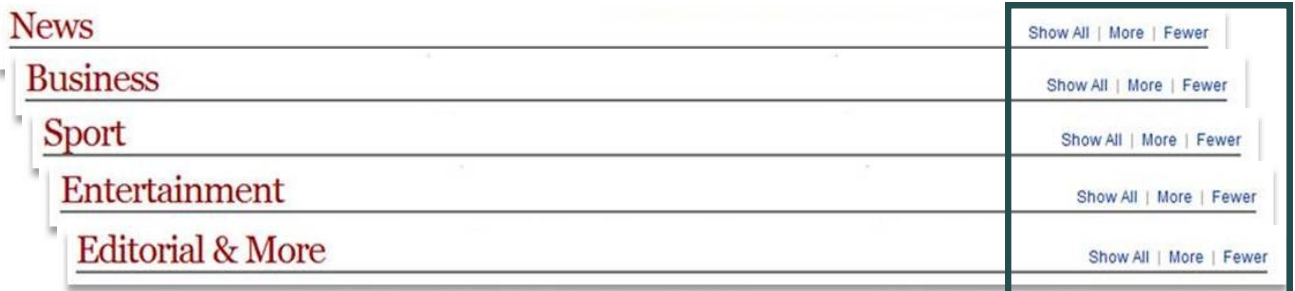
The homepage can also be customized to your preferences, whether it be selection of newspapers, or stories, or language.

Increase or decrease the news stories in your chosen categories



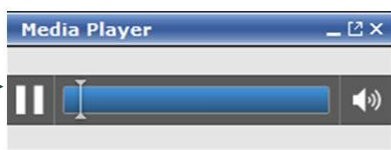
Translation
