

Wireless Windows Vista Setup Guide

Before you begin:

1. switch on your wireless network card radio

1. Proxy Script Configuration

❖ Internet Explorer

- i. Select "Tools" -> "Internet Options" -> "Connections" -> "LAN Settings"
- ii. Check "Use automatic configuration script"
- iii. Enter address "http://proxy-config.tp.edu.sg/proxy.pac"
- iv. Click "OK" to save the settings
- v. Click "OK" to close "Internet Options"

❖ Mozilla FireFox

- i. Click on "Tools" -> "Options"
- ii. Under "Network" tab select "Settings"
- iii. Check "Automatic proxy configuration setting URL"
- iv. Enter address http://proxy-config.tp.edu.sg/proxy.pac
- v. Click "OK" to save the settings
- vi. Click "OK" to close "Options"



2. Windows Zero Configuration

- i. Click "Start" -> "Control Panel"
- ii. Click on "System Maintenance"
- iii. Click on "Administrative Tools"
- iv. Double-click on "Services"

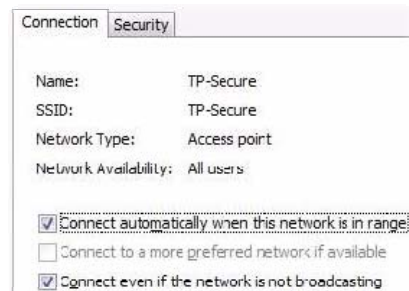
- v. In the "Services" box scroll down the list of "Services (local)" and double-click on "Wired AutoConfig"
- vi. In the "Wired AutoConfig Properties (Local Computer)" box change the "Startup" type to "Automatic"
- vii. Select "Start" and then "OK"
- viii. Double-click on "WLAN AutoConfig"
- ix. In "WLAN AutoConfig Properties (Local Computer)" box change the "Startup" type to "Automatic"
- x. Select "Start" and then "OK"
- xi. Select "File" and "Exit" to close the "Services" window



3. Set SSID, TP-Wlan (manual configuration)

- i. Click "Start" -> "Connect To"
- ii. Click on "Set up a connection or network"
- iii. Select "Manually connect to a wireless network"
- iv. Type in the following:
 - a. Network name: TP-Wlan (case-sensitive)
 - b. Security type: No authentication (Open)
 - c. Encryption: None
 - d. Uncheck "Start this connection automatically"
 - e. Check "Connect even if the network is not broadcasting"
 - f. Click on "Next"
 - g. In the "Manually connect to a wireless network" window, click on "Change Connection Settings"
 - h. Under "Connection" tab select:
 - i. "Connect automatically when this network is in range"

- ii. Connect even if the network is not broadcasting”



- i. Click on “OK’ to apply the settings
- j. In the “Manually connect to a wireless network” window, click on “Connect to...” (after a short wait, the TP-Wlan will show the status “Connected”



4. Logging On

- i. Launch your browser to see the wireless network login screen



- ii. Enter the following:
 - User Name: (NRIC@guest.tp.edu.sg)
 - Password: (password)
- iii. A successful login will then take you to the Welcome page
